Andrew Brown, son of the late Deacon Henry Brown, Sr. and Katie Maldonia Brown, was born on January 7, 1938, in Forrest City, Arkansas. He was the third-born in a set of triplets, along with Annie and Ella, and the twelfth child of twenty-two children.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry and Katie Brown; eighteen siblings; his soulmate of 43 years and mother of his children, Ruth Latham; and his bonus daughters, Rebecca Latham-Hoyle and Ruth Ann Latham.
