Ann Davis, (born Annie Mae Graham) was born August 8, 1943, in Forrest City, Arkansas to the late Elliott Graham and Eva Neal Graham. She attended Stewart Elementary and continued her education at Lincoln High School where she was a member of the junior choir. At the age of 16, Ann moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin to reside with her aunt and met Williams F. Davis. The two wed in 1962 and gave birth to William Jr., the first of their three children. In 1963, they welcomed their second child, their daughter Diane and welcomed their last child LaKisha in 1979.

Ann was a hard worker, entrepreneur and faithful member of the Mt. Carmel Missionary Baptist Church who loved spending time with family and patronizing the casinos in her spare time. She was a devoted employee of Briggs & Stratton until her retirement in 2002. To live out her retirement, Ann relocated back to her hometown of Forrest City to reunite with her sisters where she remained until an unfortunate medical tragedy struck in 2021 resulting in her moving to North Carolina with her youngest daughter. On Saturday, April 26, 2025, Ann went on to glory to join her parents Elliott and Eva Graham, her brothers Elliott Jr, Spencer, Arthur and Frank Graham, her husband Williams F. Davis and her daughter Diane D. Davis- Thomas.
