Cleave Whitby, Jr. was born September 26, 1959, to Cleave Whitby, Sr. and Ullar Marie Sparkman Whitby in Forrest City, Arkansas, the oldest of his siblings, Charley Earl Whitby and Eunice Whitby Crawford.

Cleave received his high school diploma from Forrest City High School (Class of 1977) in Forrest City, Arkansas. He later joined The United States Marine Corps from 1977-1980. He was a 32nd degree Mason and attended Crowley's Ridge Vocational Technical School with a focus in Carpentry. He later owned his own lawn care business. He served in many roles at Cedar Grove Church of Jesus Christ in Round Pond, Arkansas. He served as a Deacon and Sunday School Teacher. He was an Alderman on the Widener City Council where he served over 20 years. On the council he was the epitome of a servant leader. In his work and in his actions, it was apparent to all the love he had for the community. He had the biggest servant heart of anyone.

Cleave married Dorothy Mitchell Whitby (who preceded him in death), in 1994 to this union Cleave Dewayne Whitby was born. He later married Ruthie A. Burgess Whitby in 1996 and to this union Rosie Marie Whitby Clinkscale was born. He departed this life on June 20, 2023, at Baptist Memorial Hospital-Memphis.
