Elizabeth was born April 9, 1924, to Mr. and Mrs. Almo Reed in Turner, Arkansas and later moved to Hicks Station (Widener), Arkansas.

On Thursday, January 5, 2023, at Lonoke Health and Rehab Center, Missionary Evangelist Elizabeth Hill, a well-known evangelist in The Church of God in Christ Inc. and Spiritual Church, died at the age of 98. After a season of declining health, she has gained her wings and “went home.” She fought a good fight, finished the race, and kept the faith. Now, according to Second Timothy 4:7-8, “there is in store for her the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award on that day.” Armed with over 50 plus years of teaching the gospel and living for the Lord, Missionary Evangelist Elizabeth Hill, acclaimed teacher, evangelist, revivalist, and giver from her heart has radically impacted the lives of thousands of believers. Missionary Hill became known as a “cheerleader for the Lord,” dancing and shouting on one foot throughout her time in ministry. She would often say, “The reason I’m running so, I don’t want to be lost”, “I got overheated and haven’t cooled off yet for the Lord,” “You can’t hate me and claim you love God or you’ll die and go to the lake, and it isn’t Lake Michigan,” “That man been might nice to me so I put a handle on his name and call Him, Mr. Good Jesus.” She’s leaving a legacy that will continue to impact many.

Missionary Evangelist Elizabeth Hill was one of the strongest faith anchor and childhood influence. She was described as the “community’s spiritual voice” and “the epitome of a faith-walker”. She grew up and accepted salvation and received the Holy Ghost under Bishop J.H. Jennings at an early age and later moved her membership to Redeeming

Christian Spiritual Church #1 under the leadership of Bishop Therother Phillips and was still an active member until her health failed under the leadership of Pastor Barry F. Phillips.

Missionary Evangelist Elizabeth Hill met and married John Hill in the late 1940's in Twist, AR and was faithful until his death in 2007 and to this union they had one daughter, Mary Elizabeth Hill.

Missionary Evangelist Elizabeth Hill leaves to cherish her one and only daughter, Mary Elizabeth Hill Dolphin (James Dolphin) of Forrest City, AR; three grandchildren, Ashley Hill, Shardai Appleby, and Deshaviyun Appleby all of Forrest City; seven great grandchildren, Nikiya Drone, Jayveon Appleby, Ta'Liyah Ursery, Rashad Ursery, Zylen Rodgers, Amari Appleby, and Kadarius Henderson, and a host of God children, cousins, other relatives, and friends.
