Mr. Everet Munson was born on July 8, 1927 to the late JB and Pearlle Marchbanks Munson. Mr. Everet Munson better known as “Munson” confessed his hope and belief in Christ at an early age. Munson was a U.S. Army Veteran. He attended school at Hawkins & Dunbar High School, where he graduated and worked for Bristol-Myers Squibb. During those years he met and married on January 1, 1948 his beloved wife for 62 years, the late Curley Mae Minor Munson until death.

Munson was an Arkansas native and later moved to Pontiac, Michigan, Gary, Indiana, Chicago, Illinois, and later moved back to Palestine, Arkansas. On Thanksgiving 1990 he and his wife joined Stanley Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Colt, Arkansas. Munson worked in the church as a deacon until his demise. Munson loved his family and friends.

Munson was preceded in death by his wife, Curley Minor Munson; parents, JB and Pearlle Marchbanks Munson; siblings, Ruby Walker and Almetter Thompson.

On Wednesday, December 11, 2019 Munson made his transition.
