



## Mr. Ezekiel Kinchen Jr.

June 26, 1944 - June 20, 2024

Ezekiel Kinchen, Jr. was born on June 26, 1944, to Ezekiel Kinchen, Sr. (deceased) and Essie Lee Kinchen (deceased), in Helena, Arkansas. He was the middle child in a family of eight children.

Ezekiel accepted Christ at an early age.

He graduated from Eliza Miller High School, in West Helena, Arkansas in 1963. Ezekiel embarked on his college education at Agricultural Mechanical & Normal College in Pine Bluff Arkansas, where he obtained his Bachelor of Arts in 1965. He further continued his educational journey by attending and graduating University of Tennessee in 1975 with a Master of Science in Social Work.

Ezekiel served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from 1969 to 1971. Ezekiel also worked at The Department of Health & Human Services in Helena, Arkansas for several years and eventually moved to Little Rock, Arkansas in 1984 where he resided for 40 years until his untimely death.

Ezekiel departed this life Thursday, June 20, 2024.

He leaves to cherish three sisters, Laly B. (Lonzo) Hudson of Chicago, Illinois; John Ester Kinchen and Ruthie Baker, both of Detroit, Michigan; Ezekiel also leaves to mourn five beautiful daughters Angela Tukes (Greg) of Township, MI, Alicia McCrae, Bernadette Hughes, and Antonette Hill all of Atlanta, GA and Ashia Caldwell of Marion, AR. He also leaves a host of grandchildren, and great grandchildren as well as a multitude of nephews, nieces, cousins, and many friends.

Ezekiel was preceded in death by his parents, sister, Mary Lean Kinchen and brothers, Sammie Lee Kinchen, Joe Nathan Kinchen and Robert Kinchen.

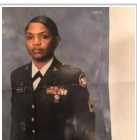
