Jacobie Frandell Butler, “Cobie”, was born on Christmas Day, December 25, 1989 to Herman and Charlene Phillips Butler in Memphis, Tennessee.

He accepted Christ and was baptized November 5, 2005 at St. Mary Redeeming Spiritual Church in Madison, Arkansas by Elder Timothy McFadden, but he was under the leadership of Pastor Bessie Goff. He later united with the Whole Bible Church Jesus Christ under the leadership of Apostle D. A. Wirt and was baptized in Jesus’ name on November 11, 2018.
