Johnnie was a member of the Forrest City High School Class of 1975. He was definitely "one-of-a-kind" and possessed many talents. After graduation, he toured with the late Blues singer Albert King as a drummer. He was also a successful song writer.

Johnnie later began his trucking career as a driver for the family business, Malone Trucking, where he found his true passion. He was a loner and loved traveling. Johnnie was employed by S.D. H. Trucking Company of Bakersville, California at the time of his death.
