Johnnie Mae Vincent (Madea) was a beautiful woman of God who truly loved the Lord with all her heart, soul, and being. She had a personal relationship with God which spanned over 75 + years. She accepted Christ at an early age and has never deviated from serving him. He was her best friend and her confidante. Her personal relationship with him was amazing to witness and experience. She was a role model for all who came into her presence.

Madea taught all who knew her life-changing lessons about love, perseverance, forgiveness, and support. She was a gracious, giving, understanding, and patient woman who never gave up on others. She was a comedian at heart who loved to laugh and always extended an outreached hand to others.

Madea loved attending church and praising the Lord. During her younger years she was a member of Mt. Gilliam AME Church. Later she joined Greater Miracle Temple where she had the opportunity to do what she loved most—sing solos and lead praise songs! As time progressed, it became difficult for her to commute to Greater Miracle Temple, but she did not allow that to stop her from going to church. She joined Victory Temple Church of God in Christ

under the leadership of her son-in-law (Elder Oliver Smith) and her daughter (First Lady Zenna Smith) where she continued to praise God and served faithfully as one of the church mothers until her health began to fail.

This God-fearing people-loving woman was born August 1, 1928 in St. Louis, MO to the late John Kincaid Sr. and Charlotte Hoskins.
