Kendall R. Owens, age 53, passed away on Friday, Jan. 31, 2025, at 9:30 p.m., at Forrest City Medical Center. His death came suddenly and unexpectedly.

Kendall was born on April 20, 1971, in West Memphis, the son of the late Bertha Owens.

Kendall's spiritual journey began at a young age when he accepted Christ under the leadership of Rev. J.A. Toney. His academic foundation was established within the Forrest City School District, from which he graduated in 1989. Kendall's athletic skills were evident in his outstanding baseball skills, specifically as an outfielder, and he was also a valued member of the school band. He pursued higher education at East Arkansas Community College, graduating with an associate's degree.

As a devoted, diehard fan, Kendall's loyalty belonged to the Dallas Cowboys, while also fervently supporting Arkansas Razorbacks basketball and football. He was also a fan of the Lakers Nation. He took great pleasure in watching

television and engaging in PlayStation 5 gaming. Kendall further demonstrated a strong love for the Forrest City Mustangs. St. Francis County and Forrest City meant so much to him. Kendall's remarkable culinary expertise was further complemented by his love for barbecuing.

Kendall fulfilled various roles within the Forrest City School District, serving as the district's public relations director. Prior to this, he spent many years working as a reporter and photographer for Times-Herald Publishing. In 2022, Kendall was elected to the District 10 seat on the St. Francis County Quorum Court, winning by a margin of three votes. He was reelected to a second term in this past November's general election. Kendall was also a member of the Delta Regional Airport Authority Board, representing Forrest City.

The year 1991 marked the beginning of Kendall's journey with his soulmate, Lisa, and on March 19, 1994, they were united in Holy Matrimony. To this union, one daughter, Paige Marie Owens, was born. Kendall's love for his family was profound, with a special place in his heart for his wife, his daughter Paige, his grandchildren, son-in-law, brother, family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Bertha Owens.

Kendall is survived by his wife Lisa, whom he shared 34 years of love. He is also survived by one daughter, Paige Marie (Corey) Butler of Jonesboro; three grandchildren, Rilan Towner, Kaidence Butler and Noah Butler, all of Jonesboro; a brother, Clifton Cain, of Forrest City; mother-in-law, Maria Sullivan of Batesville, and host of brothers and sisters-in-law, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, other relatives, co-workers and friends.

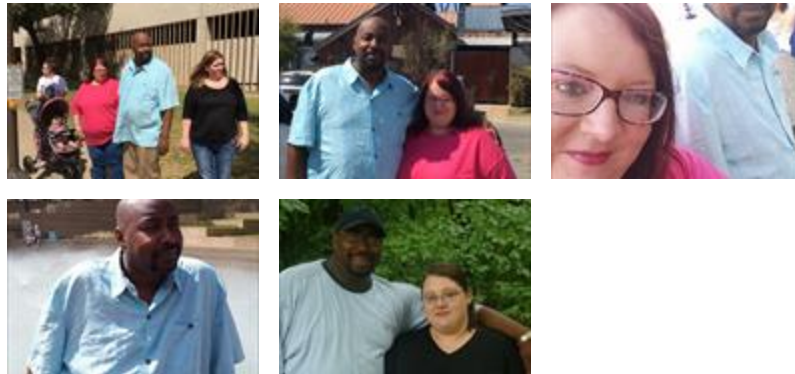
