March 21, 1959 - July 28, 2025

Lenon "Tom" Hall, affectionately known by many as the "Small Boss of Arkansas," was born on March 21, 1959, in Forrest City, Arkansas, to the union of Ms. Hattie Hall and Mr. James Hall. From his earliest days, Lenon was surrounded by a close-knit community that would come to deeply admire and value his generous heart, mechanical brilliance, and spirited personality. At an early age, he professed his faith in Christ and often found strength and spiritual fellowship at New Rising Sun Missionary Baptist Church, where he remained connected throughout his life.

Blessed with a God-given talent for mechanics, Lenon quickly earned a reputation throughout Forrest City and the surrounding communities as the go-to expert for automotive repair. community. He loved to celebrate, uplift others, and spread joy wherever he went. Above all, Lenon deeply cherished his family. Alongside Ms. Myra Stanback, the mother of his children, he built a strong and enduring legacy rooted in love, loyalty, and unity. His role as a father, grandfather, and brother was one he carried with pride and deep devotion.

On Monday, July 28, 2025, Lenon Hall transitioned from this life in Wynne, Arkansas, leaving behind a legacy of love, character, and unwavering service to others. 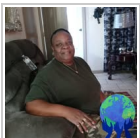
