Lorena Barnett Howard was born December 6, 1938, in Forrest City, Arkansas, to Essie Mae Davis McDowell and Leon Barnett. The eldest of six children, she was lovingly raised by her stepfather, Jessie McDowell. From an early age, Lorena displayed her strong work ethic by sweeping neighbors' yards for twenty-five cents, fifty cents, or a dollar. As she grew older, she supported her family through farm labor and by working in a café.

Lorena completed her schooling in Forrest City and also accepted Christ at Summerfield Missionary Baptist Church, where her faith became the cornerstone of her life. In adulthood, she relocated to Chicago, Illinois, and built a distinguished twenty-five-year career in the hotel industry. Upon retirement, she returned to her beloved hometown of Forrest City.

A vibrant and outspoken woman, Lorena delighted in music, television, and cooking—her birthday feasts were legendary among family and friends.

She departed this life July 10, 2025, at Forrest City Medical Center.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ernest Howard; her mother, Essie Mae McDowell; her father, Leon Barnett; her stepfather, Jessie McDowell; and her sisters, Diane Matthews and Brenda Lee Rogers. Lorena's memory will be cherished by her brother, Nickey McDowell; her
