Malcolm Charles Williford, affectionately known as “Mac,” was born on December 26, 1979, to the late Deacon Thomas E. Williford and Lottie Mae Steward Williford. On September 5, 2025, Malcolm peacefully transitioned from this life at NEA Hospital in Jonesboro, Arkansas.

At an early age, Malcolm professed his hope in Christ under the leadership of Pastor Theo Walker, remaining faithful until Pastor Walker’s passing. Later, he united with Poplar Grove Missionary Baptist Church, where he continued his Christian journey under the leadership of Pastor Pernell Brown.
