Marcell Patton, was born August 24, 1950 to O.C. Patton. Sr. and Lurie Dean Hamilton Patton. He was the 3rd oldest of 10 children born to this union.

Father, O.C. Patton Sr., mother Lurie Dean Patton Abernathy, stepfather Roosevelt Abernathy, brothers O.C. Patton Jr., Henry Patton, Sr., stepbrother Charlie Abernathy, Sr., all preceded him in death.

Marcell was united in holy matrimony to Inez Grady on March 20, 1970. To this union two children were born: Anthony and Nyela Patton.

Marcell professed a hope in Christ at an early age at the El Cannon M.B. Church in Palestine, Arkansas under the leadership of Elder Scott.
