



## Mrs. Rebecca B. Jones

May 12, 1944 - February 6, 2026

Rebecca Bailey Lewis Jones, affectionately known as “Becky,” passed away peacefully on Friday, February 6, 2026, in Fort Smith, Arkansas, surrounded by her loving family. She was born on May 12, 1944, in Forrest City, Arkansas, to Vera Marie Peoples Bailey and Sylvester Cleter Bailey, who preceded her in death. Becky was the fifth of six children and dearly loved her sisters and brother.

At an early age, she accepted Christ and united with Historic First Baptist Church in Forrest City, where she remained a faithful lifelong member. She served in numerous capacities, including Sunday School Teacher, Vacation Bible School Chairman, Church Treasurer, and Financial Secretary. Becky attended Lincoln High School, where she excelled academically and formed lifelong friendships. She later attended Arkansas AM&N College, now the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, majoring in Early Childhood Education. While in college, she played basketball and was proudly known as one of the “Bailey Girls.” During that time, she met Edward Lewis, Jr., and the two were married on June 19, 1966, in Forrest City. Their twenty-nine-year union was blessed with three daughters: Velen, Renita, and Crystal.

Rebecca taught third and fourth grades in the Forrest City School District for more than 30 years. Her commitment to education and community service extended beyond the classroom. She was a member of the Semper Fidelis Charmettes Club, served as a Girl Scouts leader, acted as a Room Mother, and was always willing to assist others. On December 31, 2000, she married Thomas Jones. They enjoyed traveling and spending time with family until his passing on September 19, 2006.

In retirement, Becky remained active and engaged. She took piano lessons, participated in step and water aerobics, and traveled extensively to visit family and friends across the country. She enjoyed spending time at the Forrest City Senior Center, where she served as President, led bingo games, and played Bean Bag Baseball. She fondly recalled trips to Branson, Missouri, Canada, and other destinations. Becky cherished family vacations and celebrated her 75th birthday in New York City. She also traveled to Mexico, Italy, The

Vatican, Greece, Turkey, and Jamaica. In her quiet moments, she enjoyed playing Sudoku and Word Cookies and watching Monk and Columbo marathons.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her brother, Clifton Bailey; her sister, Oneida Bailey Wilson; her husbands, Edward Lewis, Jr., and Thomas Jones; her granddaughter, Breyanna A. Lewis; and dear friends, Arlene Williams Mobley and Mary Norman Allen.

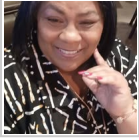
