Rosetta Braxton Cook was born on October 14, 1952, to Mr. Curtis and Mrs. Cora Boyd Braxton in Forrest City, Arkansas. She departed her earthly life on November 11, 2024, at St. Bernards Medical Center in Jonesboro, AR.

Rosetta, fondly known as "T-Baby" and "Aunt Tee" by her family, was treasured for her vibrant presence and generosity. She had a strong passion for cooking, sewing, traveling with her dear sisters, and caring for others. Family gatherings were particularly special with her presence, especially when she participated in lively games of Spades or Uno. She graduated from Forrest City High School with the Class of 1971. She married Lewis Edward Cook, Sr. on August 17, 1975, in Forrest City. Rosetta accepted Christ at nine at Rising Sun M.B. Church under Reverend Hunt's leadership, serving faithfully as a dedicated choir member, where her rendition of "Tell Me How Did You Feel When You Come Out The Wilderness" was cherished tradition after baptisms. She remained dedicated to Rising Sun and later, New Rising Sun M.B. Church under Pastor James Brook's leadership, until her passing. Additionally, Rosetta was a proud member of Spring Grove Chapter #306, Order of the Eastern Star in Forrest City, AR. She began her career at General Industries before pursuing her passion to become a Personal Care Aide for the Arkansas Department of Health in St. Francis County, where she diligently cared for others until her retirement a few years ago.
