Rosetta Cochran Conway was born February 23, 1946, to the union of the late Herman and Miranda Hall Conway Sr. in Forrest City, AR.

Rosetta completed her journey on October 16, 2023, at Baptist Hospital-Memphis.

Rosetta attended Beth Salem Missionary Baptist Church with her parents as a child. She graduated from Lincoln High School with the class of 1965 in Forrest City, Arkansas where she was active in many of the school's programs and was a proud majorette. After graduating from high school, she attended AM&N (Arkansas Agricultural, Mechanical and Normal College) known now as University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, and furthered her education at the Arkansas State University- Jonesboro, and graduated from Christian Brothers University in Memphis, TN.

Rosetta used her entrepreneurial skills and was instrumental in the founding of one of the longest family-owned businesses in Forrest City, AR, Cochran Car Wash and Tire Service known now as Cochran Auto. Shegan her employment with Social Security Administration for over 20 years and later was employed by Emerson Motors where she retired. When Rosetta retired, she became a MARY KAY consultant, active with the local chapter of AARP, and as an assistant to the St. Francis County Clerk [Brandi Holley]. She cherished her time working and the colleagues she worked with during her career. She was an avid reader, historian, organizer, and philanthropist. She was an active member at the Scott Street Church of Christ where she served as the youth Sunday School teacher for many years.
