Rosie Lee Saine Granberry, along with her twin, was born to Nathaniel and Mary Saine on December 24, 1947, in Palestine, Arkansas. She was the fourth of five children.

Affectionately known as Rosie, she accepted Christ at an early age at Salem Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Owens. She was also a member of Rising Sun Missionary Baptist Church, and St. John Missionary Baptist Church, and in 2013 she returned to Salem Missionary Baptist Church. She was a member of the Singles Mission Ministry and participated in the district choir.

Rosie graduated from Lincoln High School in Forrest City, Arkansas, in 1965. On May 19, 1968, Rosie married Donald Granberry and moved to St. Louis, Missouri for fourteen years, and they had one child, Danielle Nalari Granberry Jones.

Rosie returned to Forrest City, Arkansas, where she furthered her education at

East Arkansas Community College and worked at Sanyo. Her passion was working with young students. She left Sanyo and became a teacher's aide at Forrest City High School and Central Elementary School until she retired.

Rosie had a beautiful smile and heart. She loved her family and was always encouraging. "Hold it in the Road" were words of wisdom she would often say. She was known for her quick wit, and love of travel and had her own flair for fashion including hats, purses, and boots.

Rose Lee Saine Granberry departed this life on November 2, 2023. She was preceded in death by her parents, Mary Savannah Saine and Nathaniel Saine, Sr., and her brother, James Arthur "Peabody" Saine. She leaves to cherish her memory, her daughter, Danielle Nalari Granberry Jones; one grandson, Andrew L. Hendricks, and two granddaughters, Megan L. Jones and Madison L.
