March 25, 1951 - May 2, 2020

Elder Little Scott Logan, better known as “Straight Razor”, was born March 25, 1951 in Little Rock, Arkansas to Rose Mary Logan and Arizona Logan, both of whom preceded him in death. His wife, Missionary Mother Mary Lee Logan, and his daughter, Charline Angelina Logan, also preceded him in death, as well as two brothers—Aldoph Parker and James Parker.

Elder Little Scott Logan gave his life to Christ under the fellowship of Superintendent William Thomas of Bountiful Blessing COGIC in Forrest City, Arkansas. He later joined Empowerment for Life Christian Center, under the leadership of Pastor Alvin Coleman and then later under Pastor Reginald Everett.

Elder Little Scott Logan began his career at the age of fourteen driving for the Coco Cola Plant in Forrest City, Arkansas for a couple of years. Then he worked for Willie Shaw driving trucks for many years. He worked for Bill Lilla Trucking Company, Land Star Trucking, JCB Trucking, Earl Woods Trucking, etc. He ended his truck driving career driving for Nox Trucking.
