Mr. Sean Monte Brady, 57, of Forrest City, Arkansas, departed this life on Saturday, May 30, 2026, at Forrest City Medical Center. He was born October 29, 1968, in Forrest City, Arkansas, to the late Mrs. Daisy Burks Brady and Mr. Lonzo Brady.

Sean graduated from Forrest City High School in 1987 and furthered his education at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff. He was currently employed with the St. Francis Area Developmental Center, where he faithfully dedicated his time and service to helping others.

Mr. Sean M. Brady proudly served in the United States Army from August 16, 1988, until September 18, 1992. During his military career, he attained the rank of Private First Class (PFC/E-3) and served as a Cannon Crewmember with C Battery, 4th Battalion, 41st Field Artillery at Fort Carson, Colorado.

During his honorable service, Mr. Brady served overseas in Southwest Asia during the Persian Gulf War and earned numerous awards and decorations, including the Southwest Asia Service Medal with Bronze Service Star, National Defense Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Kuwait Liberation Medal-Saudi Arabia, Rifle Expert Marksmanship Badge, and Grenade Expert Marksmanship Badge. Mr. Brady faithfully served his country with dedication, courage, and honor before receiving an honorable

discharge under honorable conditions in 1992.

Sean was a man who truly enjoyed life and never met a stranger. He loved fishing and cherished every moment spent with his family, especially his grandchildren, whom he adored dearly. He was well known for “talking noise” while playing dominoes and cards with family and friends, creating laughter and unforgettable memories that will forever be treasured. Sean also took great pride in his appearance and believed there was nobody sharper when it came to dressing and fashion. His confidence, unique style, and vibrant personality made him stand out wherever he went. He was also an avid Dallas Cowboys fan and proudly supported his team every season.

Sean’s warm smile, loving spirit, and joyful personality touched the lives of many. His presence will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

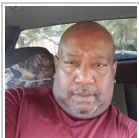
