Yet, Ted's love for swimming often outweighed the consequences of the old peach tree or willow switches waiting for him afterward.

Ted was an avid hunter with exceptional shooting skills. Family and friends

could always count on Ted returning home with numerous rabbits or squirrels in his game tote. He also possessed a deep sense of love and responsibility for his family from an early age. During the cold winter months, Ted would rise before daybreak to make sure the fireplace or heater was going, ensuring his siblings awoke to warmth and comfort before starting their day. He never complained and never had to be reminded of his chores, demonstrating a servant's heart and devotion to his family throughout his life.

In his leisure time, Ted enjoyed boxing and had a deep appreciation for the sport.

Ted was preceded in death by his father, Ted Eugene Fryer, Sr.; and his brothers, Larry "Preacher" Fryer and Melvin Fryer.
