Terrence Antionne Powell was born to William "Bill" Powell and Evelyn Laruth Powell on October 24, 1983. He was the youngest of five (5) siblings. Born and raised in Wynne, AR, he attended Wynne High School, where he played basketball for the Yellowjackets, and honed his talent for rap. He was a graduate of the class of 2003. He was united in matrimony to Morsie "Shay" Hunt on May 12, 2012, and to this union, in addition to his oldest child, Shemar Powell, 3 children were born: Serenity, Kamron, and Kingston Powell.

"Boosee", as he was affectionately known, was the member of a very popular rap group, "M.O.B". They performed at various locations and functions, even attending a talent competition in Atlanta, where they performed in the presence of mega-producers. Although the group eventually disbanded, Boosee maintained a love for the microphone.

Boosee was very vocal about his past addictions to drugs and alcohol. He was determined to not only get and remain sober, but to help others find the strength to recover as well. In his sobriety, he became a better husband,

father, brother, and friend. He founded his own podcast, “Mr. ShowoutTV”, discussing various issues, but his main focus was on sobriety and recovery. He remained sober even until his untimely passing. He was also attending East Arkansas Community College, seeking to become an addiction counselor, while working at Wal-Mart Supercenter in Forrest City.

Boosee was preceded in death by his father, Mr. William Powell. He leaves to cherish his memories his devoted mother, Evelyn Powell; his loving wife, Morsie Powell, 3 sons, Kamron Powell, Kingston Powell (Forrest City) and Shemar Powell (Fayetteville, AR); 1 daughter, Serenity Powell (Forrest City); his brothers Gregory (Rena) Powell (St. Paul, MN) , Jeffrey Powell (Atlanta, GA), and sisters Kimberly Jones-Thomas (Jonesboro, AR), and Melanie (Darryl) Powell-Nellon. He also leaves to cherish his memories 3 nephews and a niece that he considered his “brothers and sister”—Johnathan (Clarissa) Jones, Jeremy Jones, and John Jones, Jr. (Decoyia) and Cherri Jones, along with a host of other family and friends.

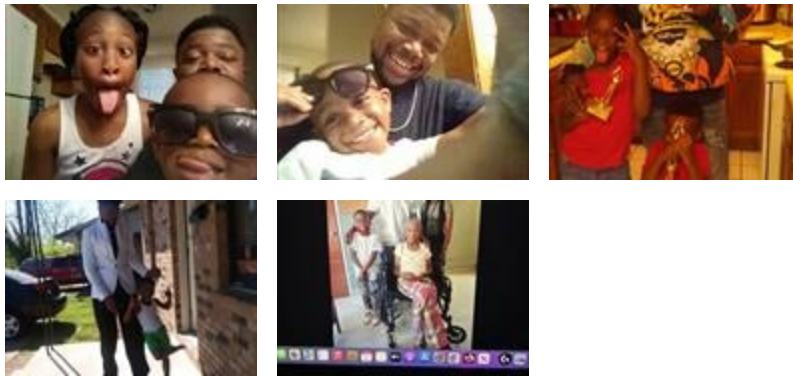
